Either form is acceptable. However, the Nominations Committee will review both forms if both are submitted.
2. In order to qualify for the A4P Senior Class Prize, the candidate must be a graduating senior in good standing from Princeton University.
3. The supporter(s) must be a teacher, adviser, community leader, student, or other adult—not related to the candidate—who knows about the candidate’s participation in the activities described in this application.
4. Please supply any additional material (photos, videos, etc...) if it would add substantially to our understanding of the activities.
5. It may be necessary for the recipient of a cash award to provide a U.S. taxpayer identification number.
6. The A4P Senior Class Award winner will be notified in May 2015 and recognized during A4P’s Reunion event in May 2015. The Award will consist of a plaque and a cash award/prize of up to \$100.
